transcosmos carries out tree-planting project at Hiyoshi Shizen-no ie, Nagasaki Prefecture

Plants a total of 160 trees in a 2,000 m² plot to achieve carbon neutrality

transcosmos hereby announces that the company will carry out a companion planting activity at Nagasaki Prefecture Hiyoshi Shizen-no ie (Hiyoshi Nature House) as part of its carbon neutral program. Through this activity, transcosmos will plant a total of 160 trees mixing diverse types of trees including Kawazu cherry blossoms, painted maple, Japanese maple, and Chinese tallow trees on a land of approximately 2,000 m². On Monday, January 27, 2025, the company signed a tree-planting partner agreement with the prefecture at the Nagasaki Prefectural Government Office.
